<p>Apprenticeship Job Creation Tax Credit (AJCTC)</p>	<p>Eligibility: Red Seal trades only</p>	<p>Non-refundable tax credit equal to 10% of the eligible salaries and wages payable to eligible apprentices in respect of employment after May 1, 2006. Employer Signing Bonus	Source: Ministry of Training, Colleges & Universities Eligibility: *All trades *Employer has hired an Apprenticeship Scholarship candidate as an apprentice	\$2,000 Bonus for employers who register new apprentices in sectors where there is a high demand for skilled workers. <p>Employment Ontario Employment Services</p>	<p>There are local Employment Ontario Employment Service providers across the province. <p>Canada Ontario Job Grant</p>	<p>The Job Grant will provide direct financial support to individual employers who wish to purchase training for their employees. It will be available to small, medium and large businesses with a plan to deliver short-term training to existing and new employees, and will:</p> <p>Provide up to \$10,000 in government support per person for training costs.</p> <p>Require employers to contribute one-third of the total costs.
