



AUTO BODY REPAIRER - EXAM COUNSELLING SHEET

The Auto Body Repairer (310Q) examination is based on the General Performance Objectives; the “Skill Sets” identified in the Training Standard Log Book for the trade. The Training Standard describes the skills and knowledge required to perform the duties of the trade. The pass mark for the Ontario Certificate of Qualification exam is 70%.
