**ORDER**

**PURSUANT TO AN ORDER** dated August 2, 2019, this matter was heard and determined on September 9 & 10, 2019 in accordance with section 46(1)(a) of the *Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act* (the “Act”) by a three-member panel of the Discipline Committee;

**AND UPON CONSIDERING** allegations (a), (b), (c), (d), (e) and (f) in the Notice of Hearing issued August 30, 2018, College Counsel’s submissions, the Member’s submissions, and witness testimony;

**THIS PANEL OF THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE**, pursuant to section 46(2) of the Act, found the Member guilty of professional misconduct as set out in allegations (a), (b), (c), (d), (e) and (f) of the Notice of Hearing;

**AFTER MAKING A FINDING** of professional misconduct against the Member, the panel considered written submissions of College Counsel and the Member, with respect to penalty and costs, as a result of which;

**THIS PANEL OF THE DISCIPLINE COMMITTEE** made the following orders:

1. The Member shall pay, within twelve (12) months of the Order, a fine in the amount of \$2,000 to the Minister of Finance for payment into the Consolidated Revenue Fund, pursuant to section 46(5)2 of the *Act*;
2. The Registrar shall be directed to revoke the Member's Certificate of Qualification on the date of the Order, pursuant to section 46(5)1 of the *Act*;
3. The Member shall be reprimanded by the Discipline Panel in writing and the fact of the reprimand shall be recorded on the Public Register for an unlimited period, pursuant to section 46(5)1 of the *Act*;
4. The findings and the Order of the panel shall be published in summary on the College's website, with the name of the Member, pursuant to section 46(5)3 of the *Act*;
5. The Member shall pay the invoice of his interpreter, Mr. Raza Khan, for his services during the two-day hearing on September 9 & 10. The Member shall make payment within 20 calendar days of this Order, failing which that amount shall become immediately payable to the College, in trust for Mr. Khan and payable in the manner the Hearings Coordinator directs, pursuant to rule 5.01(1) of the College's *Rules of Procedure for the Discipline Committee*; and
6. The Member shall pay, within twelve (12) months of the Order, the College's costs in the amount of \$18,181.33, pursuant to section 46(5)4 of the *Act*.
