



RESIDENTIAL (LOW RISE) SHEET METAL INSTALLER - EXAM COUNSELLING SHEET

The Residential (Low Rise) Sheet Metal Installer (308R) examination is based on the General Performance Objectives; the “Skill Sets” identified in the Training Standard Log Book for the trade. The Training Standard describes the skills and knowledge required to perform the duties of the trade. These standards and the examination were developed in consultation with representatives from trade. The pass mark for the Ontario Certificate of Qualification exam is 70%.
