1. Call to Order/Welcome

The Chair called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

2. Approval of Agenda

The agenda was approved as circulated.

3. Conflict of Interest

No conflicts of interest were declared.

4. Previous Minutes

ON A MOTION DULY MADE BY D. Guilbeault, SECONDED BY J. Sleva AND CARRIED, the draft minutes of the Trade Board's October 25, 2013 meeting were approved as tabled.

5. Update on Trade Board Resolutions & Issues

The members discussed the negative publicity the College receives from time to time and it was suggested members play a role in promoting the accomplishments and effectiveness of the College to date.

6. College of Trades Update

6.1 Classes of Membership and Fees Update

The Program Coordinator advised members that as of April 8, 2014, all deemed apprentices are required to pay an annual membership fee of \$60. Failure to do so could result the apprentice's Registered Training Agreement being cancelled. She requested that Trade Board members remind their apprentices of this date, noting that the College has mailed out letters to all apprentices reminding them of the date as well.

6.2 Enforcement and Compliance Update

The Program Coordinator provided an update on the activities of the Enforcement and Compliance division.

6.3 Scopes of Practice Update

The Program Coordinator advised Trade Board members that the Board of Governors has decided not to proceed with the Scopes of Practice Framework Review project at the present time.

7. Program Update

7.1 Trade Statistics

The Program Coordinator provided the latest statistics from the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities and the College.

8. Compulsory Certification Request

The Program Coordinator reviewed the process and considerations involved in a trade classification review. Members discussed the length of a possible Certificate of Qualification exam exemption, alternate assessment possibilities, and the scope of practice of their trade.

ON A MOTION DULY MADE BY J. Sleva, SECONDED BY F. Roy, and CARRIED, the Trade Board will notify the Construction Divisional Board of its intent to request a trade classification review of the Drywall Acoustic and Lathing Applicator trade, which is currently classified as a voluntary trade, and that the formal request for a trade classification review will be made to the Board of Governors on April 14, 2014.

ON A MOTION DULY MADE, SECONDED and CARRIED, the Trade Board recommends that the scope of practice for the Drywall Acoustic and Lathing Applicator trade be reviewed and amended to ensure that it accurately reflects all aspects of the trade.

The Chair confirmed that the next meeting of the Trade Board is scheduled for May 23, 2014.
