#### 1. Call to Order/Welcome

The Chair called the meeting to order at 9:20 a.m. The Program Coordinator officially welcomed the Drywall Finisher & Plaster and Hazardous Materials Worker Trade Board.

#### 2. Approval of Agenda

The Trade Board asked that an election for a new Vice-Chair be added to the Agenda. **ON A MOTION MADE BY S. Khan, SECONDED BY E. Brennan AND CARRIED**, the agenda was approved as amended.

#### 3. Conflict of Interest

No conflicts of interest were declared.

#### **4. Previous Minutes**

The Trade Board reviewed the March 6, 2015 draft minutes and requested some changes in the 'College of Trades Updates' section. **ON A MOTION DULY MADE BY L. Emond, SECONDED BY R. D'Angelo AND CARRIED** the draft minutes of the Trade Board's March 6, 2015 meeting were approved as amended.

#### **5. Update on Trade Board Resolutions & Issues**

##### **5.1 Academic Entry Requirement (AER) Consultation**

The Program Coordinator advised that, with the Dean Review currently in progress, the College's AER consultation has been delayed but it is still part of the College's projects for 2015/2016. The Trade Board discussed its earlier resolution that the trades of Hazardous Materials Worker and Exterior Insulated Finish Systems Mechanic should be part of the AER consultation once the project is initiated.

#### **6. Program Update**

##### **6.1 Red Seal – Drywall Finisher and Plasterer exam update**

The Program Coordinator advised that the new Red Seal Drywall Finisher and Plasterer exam will be implemented in Ontario on July 6, 2015. The Program Coordinator also described the process and the work that was done between the College and the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities (MTCU) in order to make the switch from a Provincial exam over to an Interprovincial Red Seal exam, some of which included notices and letters to affected parties such as Apprentices, Journeypersons and Employers in the trade.

##### **6.2 Hazardous Materials Worker Schedule of Training – Update**

The Program Coordinator provided the Trade Board with an update on the current status of the Hazardous Materials Worker (253H) Schedule of Training and the work that the Trade Board has done to date on the preface change regarding Asbestos Abatement Worker certification. The Program Coordinator also described the new standards approval process both internally within the College's governance structure and externally with the MTCU.

##### **6.3 Trade Fact Sheets**

The Program Coordinator displayed the Earnwhileyoulearn.ca website and advised that the College will be developing new Trade Fact Sheets – a one page resource that serves as an introductory piece to the trades. The Fact Sheets will be used primarily by high school students, youth, and people looking to enter a career in the skilled trades. The Trade Board supported the idea and agreed to review the draft Fact Sheets for the Drywall Finisher and Plasterer and the Hazardous Materials Worker trades.

##### **6.4 Apprenticeship/OCOT Membership Stats**

The Program Coordinator displayed OCOT membership stats. The Trade Board discussed the statistics of the various College membership classes for the Drywall Finisher, Hazardous Materials Worker and Exterior Insulated Finish Systems Mechanic trades.

#### **7. College of Trades Update**

**7.1 Tony Dean Review**

The Program Coordinator provided an update regarding the Dean Review. He advised that the written submissions have been posted online and showed the Trade Board where to access the submissions on the Dean Review website.

**7.2 Construction Divisional Board Update**

The Trade Board reviewed the Construction Divisional Board’s March 4, 2015 meeting minutes. There was a discussion around the new curriculum and training standards approval process.

**7.3 Registrar’s Report**

The Program Coordinator distributed the March/April 2015 report. The Trade Board reviewed the document which led to a discussion around the College’s newly developed youth microsite (Earnwhileyoulearn.ca). The Trade Board sees the new microsite as a tool to help market its trades to youth.

**7.4 Compliance and Enforcement**

The Trade Board was updated on the College’s Compliance and Enforcement activities in the period May 2013-March 2015.

**8. Election of Vice-Chair**

R. D’Angelo was elected as the new Vice-Chair for the Drywall Finisher & Plasterer and Hazardous Materials Worker Trade Board.

The Trade Board is next scheduled to meet on November 17, 2015.
