1. Call to Order/Welcome

The Chair called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. and welcomed Trade Board members, guest R. Bronk, and College staff.

2. Approval of Agenda

4. Approval of Previous Minutes

ON A MOTION DULY MADE BY K. Elliott, SECONDED BY E. Pacheco AND CARRIED, the draft minutes of the Trade Board’s April 2, 2014 meeting were approved as tabled.

5. Trade Board Resolutions & Issues Update

- 5.1 In reference to section 7.2 of the previous minutes wherein the Trade Board requested that the Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities (MTCU) provide each Training Delivery Agent (TDA) with the statistical breakdown of exam percentages based on each of six “Blocks”, as titled in (A) through (F) of the National Occupational Analysis for the Painter and Decorator trade, the Board was advised that the Ontario College of Trades (College) is able to generate this type of statistical information.
- 5.2 In reference to section 5.4 of the previous minutes wherein the Trade Board suggested that procurement language for government tendered jobs should require the use of Certified Journeypersons holding a valid Certificate of Qualification (C of Q), and Registered Apprentices, staff shared the summary of Bill 141 with the Trade Board and advised that the College would be involved with any consultations resulting from this Bill. The Trade Board noted that the Ontario Construction Secretariat is also producing a report on this issue.
- 5.3 Staff advised that the information regarding section 7.3 of the previous minutes has not yet been received.
- 5.4 In reference to section 5.3 of the previous minutes, staff reviewed the Trades Equivalency Assessment process, including the application guide and application form. There was discussion on the feasibility of using actual employer worksites for practical assessments.
- 5.5 In reference to section 6.4 of the previous minutes regarding the suggestion that having a C of Q be equivalent to a diploma course, staff advised that this issue is out of scope for the College and initiation of changes in this area would be the responsibility of MTCU.
