ORDER

PURSUANT TO THE NOTICE OF HEARING dated June 7, 2016, this matter was heard and determined pursuant to section 46(1) of the *Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act* (the "Act") and section 13.15 of the *General By-law for the Ontario College of Trades* on Tuesday, October 25, 2016;

UPON CONSIDERING the member's admission to the allegations, an Agreed Statement of Facts and a Joint Submission as to Penalty and Costs filed by the parties; the submissions of counsel for the Ontario College of Trades; the submissions of counsel for the member, Mr. Daniel T. Tardy; and a letter of apology from the member; and

UPON FINDING the member guilty of professional misconduct as set out in allegations (a)-(c) of the Notice of Hearing and that portion of allegation (d) of the Notice of Hearing stating "*engaged in*

fraudulent conduct, which is defined as professional misconduct under Ontario Regulation 97/13, subsection 1(12)”, this Panel of the Discipline Committee ordered, with reasons to follow, that:

1. **The member**, Mr. Daniel T. Tardy, having waived his right to appeal, was reprimanded by the Panel at the conclusion of the hearing on October 25, 2016 and the fact of the reprimand shall be recorded on the Public Register of the Ontario College of Trades for a period of one (1) year, pursuant to section 46(5)1 of the Act;
2. **The Registrar** is directed to revoke the member’s Certificate of Qualification in the trade of Steamfitter (307A) effective October 25, 2016, pursuant to section 46(4)1 of the Act;
3. **The member** shall pay a fine in the amount of \$1,000.00 payable to the Minister of Finance (Consolidated Revenue Fund) within 12 months of the date of this Order, pursuant to section 46(5)2 of the Act;
4. **The member** shall pay the College’s costs in the amount of \$2,000.00 within 12 months of the date of this Order, pursuant to section 46(5)4 of the Act; and
5. **The finding** and the Order of the Panel shall be published in summary with the name of the member in the official publication of the College and on the website of the Ontario College of Trades, pursuant to section 46(5)3 of the Act.
